Who Can Enter the Competitions?

1. Each Ministry can enter unlimited teams and unlimited events
2. Ministries can join together to form a team
3. The family of the member of any Ministry can play on that ministry's team or represent that Ministry in an Individual Event
4. A team can be composed of students, friends or a family (not affiliated with a ministry)
5. Everyone is welcome to enter the competition, no matter where they are from!

Number of rounds for elimination & scoring will be based on # of teams entered by Fri., 5pm Sept. 9th (late entries on a case by case basis). Additional categories may be needed based on # of entries. **Winning teams** will be awarded ribbons or a certificate.

For Your Convenience Value-Meal Food will be available:

A recommended food donation of \$5 per person (or \$20 per family) will include tickets for each person to receive: 2 sandwiches (choose from juicy grilled hamburgers and/or mouth watering hot dogs), 1 bag of chips, 2 cookies, and one drink. Additional food and drinks will be available for purchase.

Tug of War

Adults Category: a team consists of 4 men + 2 woman (approx. 18 years old or older)

Family and kid's friends: a team consists of 1 adult male, 1 adult female, and 3 children (from same family or friends)

Children Category: teams consist of 7 children (divisions by grade and/or age)

Rules:

Single elimination tournament, 90 second time limit per tug.

Start and stop on the LONG WHISTLE.

Winner is determined by either pulling the other team's marker over the center mark or leading after the 90 second time limit. (Center mark to either team's marker is approximately one yard).

The hand of the first person in the tug line-up may not go beyond the marker on that team's side of the rope. The first infraction, the team member will be warned. The second infraction will lead to disqualification.

The anchor on the tug line CANNOT wrap the end of the rope around their bodies in any way. DISQUALIFICATION will happen on first infraction.

It is suggested that participants use gloves or other articles to cover hands and arms. NO SPIKES ON SHOES.

Posted schedule will be strictly enforced. After 2 minutes from the first call, teams not ready to tug may be diaqualified.

Volley Ball

Teams of 5 people (any age)

Rules:

Single elimination tournament.

Eleven point games. Either side on every serve may score points. Once either team reaches 10 points, both teams can then only score on serve. You must win by TWO points.

Teams will switch sides every 5 points.

No backcourt spiking. Backcourt player's feet must be touching ground if in spiking motion.

Substitutions can be made only at the server position.

Flagrant carries and net violations will not be allowed! No jungle ball!

Posted schedule will be strictly enforced. After 5 minutes from the first call, team not ready to play may be disqualified.

Teams of 2 People (any age)

Potato Sack Relay Race

Teen Team Category: consist of 4 teenagers (13 to19)

Children Team Category: consists of 4 children (12 and under)

Bean Bag Toss “Thrown in Hole”

Adult Category: teams consist of 2 adults (men’s/women’s/mixed divisions, based on entries)

Children’s Category: teams consist of 2 children (boys/ girls/mixed, 17 years old and younger)

Poleish Game

2 people on each team throw a frizz-bee at a pole with an object on top.
